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Regions	Location	Species	Environmental Impact	2 Year Survival
Atlantic	Sackville, NB	Mix of species representing the native Acadian forest	Rehabilitation of the watershed and wildlife corridors by planting trees on abandoned farmlands.	93%
Quebec	Otter Lake and Mansfield	Red pine	Strong winds in 2013 caused much blow down of trees on these sites. The trees will mitigate erosion, improve fish and wildlife habitat.	93%
Ontario	Sudbury	Vairity of species such as Hemlock, Ironwood, Yellow birch	Rehabilitation of sites due to past mining practice.	94%
Prairies	Town of Rivers, MB	White spruce	Prevention of soil erosion and protecting watercourse quality.	71%
British Columbia	100 Mile House	Douglas fir, spruce, Lodgepole pine	Re-establish forest cover after Mountain Pine Beetle epidemic to provide wildlife habitat, moisture retention for soil and recreational opportunity.	89%

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
